

Southeastern U.S. Chapter report for 2017

2017 COVERAGE AREA: The Southeastern U.S. Chapter is made up of five states which do not currently have their own individual chapters: Alabama, Mississippi, Missouri, Texas and West Virginia.

MEMBERSHIP: The chapter currently has 27 paid members.

FINANCE: The chapter's individual account balance as of 12/31/17 was \$244.06.

FFLA AREA REPRESENTATIVES: The chapter continues to use 'Area Representatives' to promote FFLA activities within the member states. These Representatives are: Andrew Zerbe (Alabama); Jim Lyon (Missouri); Ralph Harp (Texas) and Robert Beanblossom (West Virginia). The position of Area Representative in Mississippi is currently vacant, with yours truly serving as a 'point of contact'.

NHLR / FFLOS REGISTRY UPDATE: Significant strides were made during the past year, especially with the West Virginia listings, thanks to the efforts of Brian Powell. As of today we currently have a total of 110 NHLR listings and 105 FFLOS listings in the states covered by the chapter. Especially noteworthy is that we now have only 27 current and/or former sites to go to complete the entire state of West Virginia.

GOALS FOR 2018: Continue to serve as a support resource for the State Representatives.
